MINUTES OF MEETING HAM BROWN RESERVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS

Call to Order/Roll Call

Ms. Sanchez called the meeting to order at 11:01 a.m.

Supervisors Traynor, Secor, O'Dowd and Roche were present. Supervisor Fitzpatrick was absent.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS

Public Comments

No members of the public spoke.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS

Presentation of Engineer's Report

Mr. Guerricagoitia stated the Engineer's Report is the same Report that was previously circulated; however, it was updated on September 18, 2024 to reflect the current construction costs. He reviewed the Opinion of Probable Construction Costs Table in Section 5, which

contains updated costs based on actual bids received. The total estimated cost of the project is \$34,565,057.

Mr. Earlywine recommended approval, in substantial form.

On MOTION by Mr. Roche and seconded by Mr. Traynor, with all in favor, the Engineer's Report, in substantial form, was approved.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Presentation of First Supplemental Special Assessment Methodology Report

Ms. Cerbone stated the First Supplemental Special Assessment Methodology Report was updated to mirror the costs data in the Engineer's Report. The plan is to fund approximately \$9.9 million in costs of the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) relating to 564 units, with an estimated cost of \$24.6 million. Ms. Cerbone reviewed the Appendix Tables in the back of the Methodology Report, including debt assessments.

Discussion ensued regarding the HOA, interest rates, bond pricing and locking in bond pricing.

On MOTION by Mr. Roche and seconded by Mr. Traynor, with all in favor, the First Supplemental Special Assessment Methodology Report dated October 23, 2024, in substantial form, was approved.

- Provides bond funds to for pay all or a portion of the costs of the Series 2024 Project.
- Includes exhibits, such as Schedule I, a project cost table, First Supplemental Indenture, Bond Purchase Contract (BPC), Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum (PLOM), Rule 15c pre-qualification certificate and Continuing Disclosure Agreement (CDA).
- Employs a Negotiated Sale of the Series 2024 bonds to the Underwriter (Section 4).

 Ms. Bligh reviewed the parameters of the Series 2024 bonds as outlined in Section 5.
- Mr. Earlywine stated the Resolution authorizes Mr. Kessler to sell the bonds and approves the forms of documents noted, which are basically drafts that can be revised.
